Set on a generous 0.37 hectares (0.91 acre) lake-shore site, this property offers an exciting opportunity for further development to become a stunning destination venue, glamping site, guest house, or other tourist related enterprise in one of the West of Ireland's most stunning locations. Another alternative is to convert the Lounge area into two self-contained apartments (subject to PP) while retaining the existing bar. The dwelling house has just been fully refurbished (completed 1st May 2025)

Heating is by means of Oil-Fired Central Heating (new boiler and radiators fitted)

throughout together with an oil stove.

Tarmacadam was recently laid around the property together with a small concrete yard area and hard surface area was cleared to the rear of the site.

Nestled on the north shore of the majestic Lough Mask and sheltered by the breath-taking Partry Mountain range this property enjoys a tranquil, rugged setting and phenomenal lifestyle and commercial prospects.

Peppered with stunning walking routes and beauty spots, Tourmakeady is an angler's paradise thanks to the rich brown trout fishing that is to be enjoyed on Lough Mask.

The village boasts rich hunting grounds too, offering great sport for game shooting and wild fowling as well as a thriving population of deer in the surrounding highlands.

The area is also one of Ireland's few remaining Gaeltacht regions (where the Irish language is still spoken), adding to its truly unique appeal.

This property was recently upgraded with double-glazed uPVC windows and doors throughout, the roof was replaced (felt and tiling), parts of the property were slabbed and insulated, replumbed, new sanitary wear/bathrooms fully renovated.

Enhanced BER available as a result, however, BER advertised was assessed prior to upgrade works.

ACCOMMODATION

Spanning over 381 sqm this property oozes charm and while its first floor accommodation requires additional capital expenditure / updating a discerning buyer with vision will find lots of inspiration here to transform the Lough Mask Inn into a statement property.

The front bar is accessed via a small entrance hall with a second side entrance accessible via a veranda area.

The bar is 9.30m x 4.14m and features an adjoining store and keg room with their own separate access from the front of the building.

It leads into a spacious lounge (12.15m x 7.86m) which has been insulated (slabbed) and renovated. The lounge has an adjoining pool room and separate male and female toilets (accessed via the side entrances to both the lounge and bar).

Residential accommodation is located to the rear of the ground floor keg room and store area and is comprised of a sitting room (4.23m x 3.42m), an ample kitchen/diner (8.83m x 3.00m), an adjoining utility space and a toilet.

The first floor accommodation has been fully refurbished and is laid out with three bedrooms together with a shower room.

DIRECTIONS

Tourmakeady is located in south county Mayo and is just a short drive from the Galway border.

The Lough Mask Inn is on the outskirts of the village as one enters on the R300 route which skirts the lake shore and connects with the main N84 route between Castlebar and Galway at Partry.

Tourmakeady boasts great amenities including a shop, GAA Club, primary school and an Irish speaking secondary school.

The county town of Castlebar and the tourist hotspots of Westport and Cong are all within an hour's drive while local visitor attractions include Tourmakeady woods and waterfall, the angling hotspots of Loughs Mask, Carra and Corrib, Killary Fjord, and the spectacular Ashford Castle in the stunning island village of Cong.

If you are a sports fan the nearby Wild Atlantic coast and lakes offer the prospect of lots of great water-based pursuits.

If dry land is your preferred territory, then Ballinrobe has vast appeal with its golf and racecourses. It is only 20 minutes' drive from Tourmakeady.

The Lough Mask Inn is also just an hour's drive from Ireland West Airport Knock.
